## NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD

## ENCAMPMENT RESOLUTION FUNDING GRANT PROGRAM ROUND 3, LOOKBACK DISBURSEMENT (ERF-3-L)

In consideration of the response to the *Notice of Funding Availability*<sup>1</sup> and additional funds authorized by SB-101<sup>2</sup> and enacted by SB 197<sup>3</sup>, the California Interagency Council on Homelessness (Cal ICH) intends to award ERF-3-L funds to the following jurisdictions in addition to the initial awards funded through ERF-1<sup>4</sup>, ERF-2-L: $^5$ , and ERF-2-R  $^6$   $^7$ .
