



STATEWIDE HOMELESSNESS FUNDING NAVIGATOR SUMMARY

The Statewide Homelessness Funding Navigator highlights the major homelessness-related investments administered by Council member departments and is designed to support coordinated, equity-driven planning, strengthen local homelessness response systems, and align investments to achieve measurable impact.



Purpose

This Navigator is an interactive tool that helps people with lived expertise, advocates, policymakers, leaders from local and Tribal governments, and Continuums of Care strategically navigate major State and Federal homelessness investments administered by Cal ICH Council member departments and agencies.



How to Use

Within the interactive tool users can sort by the following categories:

- Administering Department
- Eligible Applicants
- Eligible Uses
- Target Populations

Users can also learn more about program specific guidance and information by clicking the view more icon for each funding source.

Navigator categories have been consolidated to support users to more effectively search the listed investments. Some programs may have additional statutory or program-specific eligibility requirements, particularly those connected to entitlement or mainstream benefit programs. Users should consult administering department's guidance for detailed eligibility criteria.
